#### **Course Description**

Creating talking stories will brighten the lives of every student! Pictello is a wonderful, inexpensive and easy app used to create talking photo albums and books on an iPad, iPhone or iPod touch. Students and teachers can create text-driven speaking photo or image-rich stories using text-to-speech technology in a variety of voices. Projects can be shared through iTunes Sharing, via WiFi using a free account on the Pictello sharing server or by exporting stories to PDF. Completed stories can also be printed! Designed by Assistware for special needs students, Pictello is a super-exciting way for all non-readers and developing readers and writers of all ages to enjoy and share their creativity! \*Pictello requires iOS 5.1.1 or later and runs on all third generation iPhone and iPod touch models and upwards and all iPad models. Supported devices include the third generation iPod touch (with built-in speaker), the fourth generation iPod touch (with built-in speaker and camera), the fifth generation iPod touch, iPhone 3Gs, iPhone 4, iPhone 4s, iPhone 5, the original iPad, iPad 2, iPad 3, iPad 4, and iPad mini.

- Learn to use the app, Pictello on your iPad, iPhone or iPod device
- Interact with the instructor as assignments are completed
- Create Pictello projects to share with the instructor and with fellow students
- Create a lesson project where students uses Pictello
- Post to an ongoing discussion board your reflective thought on the use of Pictello
