Course Overview

Utilize Google Forms, a free Google App, to create rubrics, assignments, assessments, and more. Learn more than 50 creative uses of the applications! Use Google Forms to differentiate learning and automatically assess student progress.

Course Objectives:

The focus of this online course includes learning the specific skills necessary to create Google forms that differentiate learning and can be used in a Flipped / Blended Learning Environment. This course goes beyond learning the skills of creating a form.

In this course, participants will have opportunity:

- To gain an understanding of the many uses of Google Forms.
- To create and share basic forms
- To use Flubaroo to automatically grade results
- To create forms that differentiate
- To create self-paced lessons using forms
- To create templates to be automatically populated with form result

Course Assignments

Part I – Introduction to Google Forms

This first part of the course will entail learning the fundamentals of Google Forms. Participants will learn how to create and share a form. Then, they will set up the automatic grading using Flubaroo and analyze the results.

Part II: Creating Extreme that Engage Learning

The second part of this course takes the basic technology skills and puts them to good use! Many, many examples of forms will be given. Participants will create forms to use in the flipped / blended classroom, to use as a differentiation tool, and more. Part II is about learning how to USE the skills help the teacher in a student-centered environment.
