Explore the diverse features of Quizlet to create engaging study sets, flashcards and quizzes that can measurably enhance learning. Discover how to incorporate advanced features of analytics, collaboration, incorporation of multimedia elements, integration of AI, and personalized learning paths. Apply hands-on experiences, feature exploration, and reflective responses to further Quizlet's ability to elevate academic success. This course requires a Google Account as well as a Free Quizlet Account

- Understand the various tools and features offered by Quizlet.
- Develop proficiency in creating custom flashcards, quizzes, and study sets tailored to specific curriculum goals.

Objective	Review the new AI features in Quizlet
Assignment	<p>Review the info again in this AI BLOG POST.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Create or use a set of notes or any type of informative text to upload into Quizlet. Using the Magic Notes feature create the outline, summary, flashcards and essay questions from the AI Magic Notes Generator. With the free version you receive one use of this tool. If you are struggling to find content you can use CHAT GPT to create notes on content of your choosing. 2. Review the Homework Help Option under Study Tools. This feature is a paid version but will allow you to explore one or two examples for free. Use the template to review your thoughts on this tool.
Assessment	<p>Using the template provided, share the link to your magic notes along with a reflection of each of the features created by Magic Notes. Share your thoughts on this feature overall and how it can help students.
